Sacramental Preparation and Dates

Unfortunately, the Coronavirus pandemic and its many lockdowns have put many of our plans on hold. This has also impacted upon our Sacramental Programme for our children in Years 3 and 4, who are waiting to make their First Holy Communion and Year 6 who are waiting to be Confirmed. However, as we begin our journey towards normality once again, we have been able to make plans for these Sacraments to take place. Apologies for the wait in confirming these dates with you all, however, we wanted to avoid having to cancel multiple times due to restrictions in place. That being said, myself and Mr Madia met with Fr Des this week, and are pleased to inform you of the following dates:



The Sacrament of Confirmation Year 6 ~ Tuesday 6th July at 6.30pm

First Holy Communion Year 3 & 4 ~ Saturday 10th July at 11.30am

These sacraments have been planned to take place after the 21st June, when hopefully we will see the easing of restrictions on gatherings as per the Prime Minister's Road Map. However, should we need to impose any additional measures or make any amendments to these dates, we will inform you of this as soon as we can. I hope now that we are able to look forward to these special milestones in the children's Journey of Faith.

School Meals

Mrs Mockford, our talented Catering Manager, has been busy in our kitchen designing a hot meal menu. We can confirm that ALL options are very tasty indeed! We take daily orders, therefore, if your child likes the look of a particular dish, why not let them order a school meal for that day? All they need to do is inform their teacher that they would like a school meal during registration and make their selection. You can then pay for this meal via our Arbor App. Meals are currently priced at £2.22 and also include fruit or cake of the day and a bottle of water. Please remember that all children in EYFS and Years 1 & 2 are entitled to a free school meal each day.

A Jacket Potato option is also available each day. This can be served with either cheese or beans.
