#### Pupil Progress Report

All documents will be presented in a sealed envelope and given to your child to take home at the end of the day. #### End of Year Data/Attendance

On the same day, (Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July), we will be sending home your children's end of year data, detailing if your child is working at the expected level, at a greater depth or working toward the expected level. Children in Year 6 will also be bringing home their SATs results. Children in Year 1 and Year 2 will bring home their results from their phonics tests. Children in Year 4 will bring home their Multiplication Check results. These results will be carried forward into the next year group, ready for September 2022. 
Belgrade — Blue <mark>Godiva - Green</mark> Herbert — Yellow <mark>Trinity — Red</mark>
