Dear parents, children, staff and parishioners,



Everyone at St Gregory's is greatly saddened to learn of the death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Her tireless service to our country — from her early days as a dutiful young monarch to her later years as one of the world's longest and most eminent serving heads of state — makes her a source of admiration in all our school. We would like to express our sincere condolences; our thoughts are with her family at this difficult time.

There will be a ten-day period of national mourning, and as you would expect, our school will participate appropriately in aspects of these. School will be open as usual during this time. As is fitting with a period of national mourning, our school will limit communication, including on social media platforms, to essential information only. Our staff will be providing support to our children and to each other at this sad time.

Special assemblies and class prayer times will focus on helping everyone understand this unprecedented time in our nation's history and, during this time of mourning and beyond, regular time will be dedicated throughout the school day to support our family as we all come to terms with such sad news.

As a 14-year-old princess, Queen Elizabeth II addressed the children of the Commonwealth saying, "And when peace comes, remember it will be for us, the children of today, to make the world of tomorrow a better and happier place."

I hope that we can all find some comfort in these words.

School will close to all year groups (Nursery to Year 6) on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September for the whole day as this has been confirmed as a national Bank Holiday for our nation.

<mark>8.55am Lateness</mark> Following the drift in between 8.40am and 8.55am all children will be in school. Any children arriving after 8.55am will be marked late in the register. 8.55am is the legal start to the day and the register is taken at this time. We are going to be making further steps to reduce lateness working with families who are not ensuring their child is in school by 8.55am.

New end of the daytime School will end at 3:15pm each day. Gates will open from 3:10pm.

Procedures for Absences If we have not heard from a parent concerning a child who is absent by 9:10am, we will make a telephone call to ensure the child is safe. It is imperative that we know by telephone that a child is not expected to be in by 9:10am otherwise we will telephone. If we still cannot make contact, then Mrs Sweatman (Pastoral Team) or Mrs Feeney (Academy Attendance Officer) may make a visit to the family home.

- Letters the vast majority of letters will not be printed and will be emailed to your Arbor account.
- CASHLESS -we are a cashless school and do not accept cash/cheques for school meals, trips, music lessons etc please use the Arbor APP to pay for activities.

Here at St Gregory's, we are keen to grow leaders of the future and want to involve the children in our decision making as much as possible — it is their school after all! We cannot wait to implement our pupil leadership structure leading on from the success of our roles of House Captain and Vice-Captains. Over the next few weeks, children in Key Stage Two will have the opportunity to apply for a place on our school council. The children will be asked to submit an application (the format is up to them) detailing why they should be a member of our School Council. They will then be elected and enrolled for their term of office.

Last year's House Vice-Captains have now stepped up to their senior position of House Captain, meaning that we are looking for four new Vice-Captains from our Year 5 pupils. Application forms will be distributed over the coming weeks.

Finally, we have two exciting positions available for our Year 6 children to undertake. We are looking to recruit next Head Boy and Head Girl. Those who wish to be considered will write a manifesto and deliver this to the children within school. We will then host a school voting week where each child will vote for who they wish to be elected as Head Boy and Head Girl and represent our school and vocalise the children's thoughts.

This is a very exciting time for us as we hope that these initiatives will help develop confidence and independence within the children who apply and give a voice to the rest of the children at school so that we can make changes for the better.

#### Birthday Gift!

Reminder - for children on their birthday or the nearest school day to their birthday — they can come to school in <u>non-uniform</u>. This way, everybody within the school community who (sees them, will know that it is their special day.



To clarify, if a birthday is on the weekend or within school holidays the child may come in non-uniform on the Friday before or the Monday afterwards. Please no birthday cakes into school, as it takes the staff too long to cut up and detracts from the children's learning.
