

Reading at home.

The opportunity for a child to read aloud to an adult is an important factor when developing fluency and also assists with addressing any misconceptions in pronunciation/phonological awareness, you can also improve their understanding of what they have read by asking them questions about the text whilst listening to them.

Our school expectation is that children read to an adult 3 x a week for at least 15 minutes at a time.

We then ask that the adult signs the child's diary and notes down any difficulty so that we are able to support the children back at school. We are working on something very special in the background to help celebrate those children who are making an effort to read a book – watch this space!
