We fully understand that this can be a very distressing set of circumstances, but we can only assure you that we follow the procedures laid down by the Coventry Safeguarding Board, a copy of which is available, as is a copy of our own policy. Our Safeguarding Policy is available to view on our school website. Our Pastoral Team is made up of myself, Mrs Priest and Mrs Sweatman, and we are always on hand to support all our families.
