



Protective Behaviours Scheme of Work

As part of our PSHE Curriculum Programme of Study, after half term all classes will be completing a series of lessons based on Protective Behaviours. These lessons are modelled on the NSPCC programme 'PANTS'

During these lessons, children will be partaking in discussions and completing activities which aim to teach them the following important safety skills without giving explicit information or telling scary stories. We will be teaching our pupils about protective behaviours, using the 'PANTS' acrostic taken from the NSPCC programme:

PANTS stands for:

- Privates are private
- Always remember your body belongs to you
- No means no
- Talk about secrets that upset you
- Speak up, someone can help

The lessons will be delivered in a way that are fully age-appropriate.
