#### <u>Summer Uniform</u>

#### Note about Dismissal – Please Read!

We understand how important communication is with our families; and that is why we always make sure that staff members are available to talk to on the door each morning and afternoon. However, during dismissal at home time, please can we ask that family members take the following into consideration:

- Queue in an orderly manner to collect your child; do not crowd the doors but give space to the staff member who is dismissing
- Inform the office in advance if a different person is coming to collect your child so that we can check adequate permissions are in place to ensure dismissal runs smoothly. Family members entrusted to collect your child should be listed as a contact on Arbor
- Avoid approaching the member of staff on the door directly until all children have been dismissed. We understand that there may be times you wish to speak with staff members, however, their priority at the end of the day is ensuring that all children are dismissed safely. Staff will happily talk to you once the children have been dismissed but please give them an adequate amount of time to ensure that this is done
- Likewise, if a member of staff needs to speak to you, they may ask you to wait a moment whilst they dismiss the other children in their care.
