Lent is a time to think about three key areas - Prayer, Charity and Fasting.

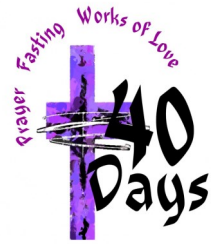
Please try to make a special effort to bring your child to mass on a Sunday during Lent.

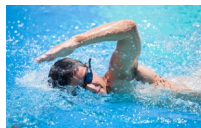


Football Match
